

## Workforce Summit

Suncoast Technical Education Center (SunTech) held its first Workforce Summit at the Florida National Guard Armories on October 12, 2016. Representatives from local employers, business partners, the Office of Economic Development and the Chamber of Commerce were present in force to discuss workforce trends.

Pertinent points raised were a shift towards automation, utilizing social media to attract a wider pool of workers, employee needs driving workforce hours, the need to instill a solid work ethic in employees, mentorship schemes and a greater need for internships and apprenticeships locally. SunTech Machining student, Darren Altimari spoke at length about his study experience at SunTech and how the skills learned have helped him progress in the workplace. Without doubt it has enhanced his skill base and increased his marketability within the manufacturing industry. He stated that more people should consider skills based training to enhance their career path.

We appreciate the feedback provided from our employers—this has resulted in SunTech exploring internship opportunities with local company 5 Star Refrigeration. We are also mentoring students who attendance habits need improving to ensure we instill good work habits into our educational training.
